Functions of the Safer Neighbourhood Board (set by MOPAC)

Enable local engagement with the police	Enable local accountability of the police	Monitor crime performance and public perceptions	Focus on the Police and Crime Plan key principles and priorities: putting victims first and reducing inequalities; keeping children and young people safe; tackling violence against women and girls and tackling hate crime and intolerance.
Monitor MPS support for the delivery of ward panels and community contact sessions	Engage with Borough Independent Advisory Groups and other local mechanisms	Inform the development of policing priorities in the borough
